

Q. Have you got any bleeding?

Ans. No.

Q. Why ?

Ans. I don't know.

Q. Can you name any body ?

Ans. No.

Q. Do you know them ?

Ans. Yes.

**Proposition.**—A totally false witness, accused can be acquitted.

**Cross-examination - Hearsay witness :**

Q. You appear quite old, can I know your name ?

Ans. My name is Jhuru Lal.

Q. What is your age ?

Ans. About 66 years.

Q. Can you see my face clearly.

Ans. I see you in blurred spots only.

Q. How did you see quarrel ?

Ans. It was told to me by my neighbour.

Q. By saying so are you deposing before Court?

Ans. Yes.

**Proposition.**—This is the way by which prosecution successfully brought an evidence from hearsay evidence.

**Cross-examination of real eye-witness**

**A Lady Trying to prove validity of FIR written by her husband :**

Q. Have you taken oath to speak truth ?

Ans. Yes. I have taken oath to speak truth only.

Q. It is just our proposition that your husband had gone to attack accused, is it correct?

Ans. Yes, I had restrained yet he went.
